Start:

Men and women from age group M35 and W35 in 5 year age groups

Disciplines:

Men: 100 M, 200 M, 400 M, 800 M, 1 500 M, 5 000 M, 10 000 M, 110 M hurdles, 100 M hurdles (According to age group), 400 M hurdles, 300 M hurdles, 200 M hurdles (According to age group), 3 000 M steeplechase, 2 000 M steeplechase (According to age group), high jump, long jump, triple jump, pole vault, shot put, discus throw, hammer throw, javelin throw, weight throw, walk 5 000 M, relay 4 x 100 M, 10 km walk race on 1 km cirkus, ½ marathon

Women: 100 M, 200 M, 400 M, 800 M, 1 500 M, 5 000 M, 10 000 M, 100 M hurdles, 80 M hurdles (According to age group), 400 M hurdles, 300 M hurdles, 200 M hurdles (According to age group), 2 000 M steeplechase, high jump, long jump, triple jump, pole vault, shot put, discus throw, hammer throw, javelin throw, weight throw, walk 5 000 M, relay 4 x 100 M, 10 km walk race on 1 km cirkus, ½ marathon

Start number:

Start numbers can be collected on presentation at the race office at the stadium on 14th August from 9:00 a.m. The allocated number will be used for all disciplines in which the athlete competes.

Changing:

Changing facilities will be available at the athletic stadium and at the basketball hall in the town of Lovosice. Toilet facilities will also be available at these venues and at the tribune.

Warm up:

Warm up before your discipline will be allowed only outwith the competition area.

Start lists:

Start lists will be displayed on the information board at the race office.

The placing of an athlete in individual races, including the draw for lanes, the starting order of competitors for field events, starting heights and height increases for high jump and pole vault events will be decided by the technical directors office.

Control of sports impliments:

All athletes will be allowed to use their own impliments in events. These impliments must be inspected by the technical referee no later than 60 minutes before the start of their event, in the tent marked for this purpose.





Presentation:

All athletes must present themselves before their event personally to the tent marked „Call room“ situated in the area of the race office building. After presentation the athlete must not leave the call room area, and to the start of his or her event will be led by an official together with the other competitors in the event.

Presentation for an event will start 15 minutes before leaving for the competition area. Times for presentation and for being led to your start or sector for individual events will be displayed in a minute timetable on the information board at the call room tent.

Athletes will be led to the start: 10 minutes before running and walking events, 25 minutes before technical disciplines, 60 minutes before pole vault.

Access to the track area:

During the competition, while events are in progress, only athletes, referees and officials will be allowed in the competition area. Failure to abide with this rule may result in athletes being penalized or disqualified.

A special area for trainers and coaches for pole vault, shot put, hammer throw and discus throw will be allocated during these events.

Results:

Results of individual competitions will be displayed on the information board at the race office. Official results will be posted on the web site of the Czech Athletic Federation: <http://www.atletika.cz/clenska-sekce/veterani/vysledky/>

Protests and objections:

Protests with regards to the results or during a competition must be made within 30 minutes after the result sheet is posted on the information board at the race office, and must be verbally communicated to the chief referee (rule no. 146 § 2, 3, 4 and 5, Athletic rules).

In the case of disagreement with the chief referee's decision on the deposit of 500 Kč and a written objection, a jury will be formed to make a final decision (rule no. 146 § 3 and 6, Athletic rules).

The jury will consist of: technical delegate, race director, head referee.

Awards:

The first three athletes in a given discipline, in all age groups will receive a medal and a diploma. Diplomas will be presented to the first 8 athletes if the athlete wants. Awards will be presented in blocks as in the time table.

Technical limits:

Competition will take place under athletic rules and the rules of WAVA. The athletic track and technical sectors have artificial surface Porplastic. The track has 6 lanes and 8 lanes on the 100 M straight. It is possible to use spikes with a maximum length of 6 mm. Organisers retain the right to change the timetable schedule depending on the number of athletes in the individual age groups.

Entries: Entries can be sent to email adress: jara.smely@seznam.cz or by registration form on the MAELO web site. The closing date for entries is 9th August 2020 at midnight. In your entry ensure you state your first name, surname, discipline, date of birth, standard time/distance/height, club and country, e-mail address.

Entries after this date will be charged at double the price.

Once all entries have been received the timetable and schedule of events will be decided.

Cost of entry:

Cost of entry for every discipline is 100 Kč/4 €. Relay events are free.

Entry fee to be paid by midnight on 9th August 2020.

Please pay entry fee through Paypal service.

Instructions for payment will be posted to your e-mail address used for registration.

Refreshments:

Refreshments will be available to buy within the stadium area.
